Registration Opens: HKSH Deputy Medical Superintendents to Host Centenary Lectures to Help Groom Young Minds

(1 November 2022, Hong Kong) In celebration of the 100th Anniversary of Hong Kong Sanatorium & Hospital (HKSH), HKSH will host two Centenary Lectures on 19 November and 3 December alongside the Exhibition "The Centenary of Hong Kong Sanatorium & Hospital" which is currently on view till 30 December 2022 at the Hong Kong Museum of Medical Sciences. During the lectures, four Deputy Medical Superintendents of the Hospital will share their stories of studying and practicing medicine in hopes of inspiring young people to engage in the medical and healthcare field while they explore their career path before entering universities.

Since its inception in 1922, HKSH has been committed to advancing clinical development and medical education.
