- Neuro-degenerative disorders, including dementia, Parkinson's disease and Alzheimer's diseases

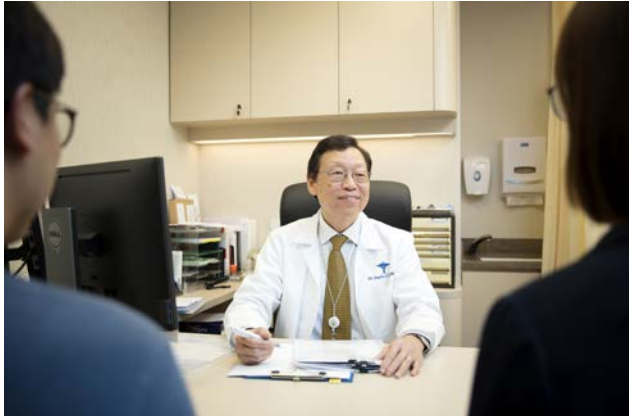
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Clinical Genetics Service

- To disseminate knowledge on genetics to the public and medical personnel.

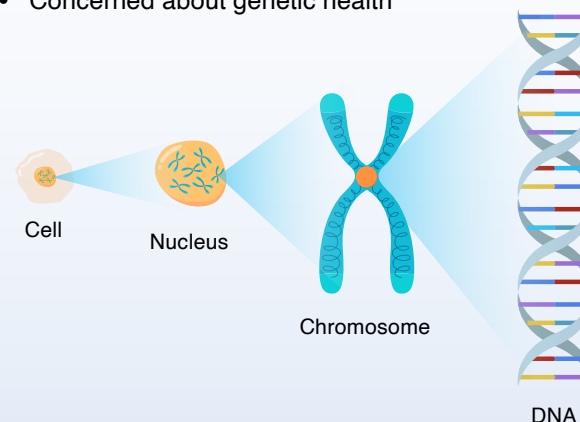
Target Groups
